VOLATILITY PROFILE: Analysis of the Average True Range (ATR) on SHORT TERM INVESTING suggests that institutional market makers are widening spreads for short term investing ahead of a projected 7% expansion velocity loop.

MOMENTUM & STRENGTH MATRIX: Key indicators for SHORT TERM INVESTING, including MACD divergence thresholds, signal an impending test of overhead distribution blocks for short term investing.
